Smart Connectivity

Smart home connectivity is when all your appliances connect or communicate by sending data through an app.

Typically, your appliances need to be within the same brand or corporation to connect through an app. You can see statistics, remote diagnostics, ventilation controls, notifications, and alerts within most smart home apps. Alerts include whether your meal is done to when a wash cycle is complete.


The most common integrations for all brands are with Google Home and Amazon's Alexa. These integrations will have step-by-step instructions to set up your appliances and voice activation.



Notifications

Smart appliance notifications often share remote diagnostics, when your food or a cycle is done, cooking instructions, or if a door is left open.

Notifications also help you stay updated on how your products are doing, from running low on detergent to maintenance alerts.



Remote Diagnostics

Remote Diagnostics is when your appliance notifies you when something is wrong or if your smart appliance is performing poorly.

When you have access to remote diagnostics, it allows you to prevent more significant problems from happening, furthering your appliance's reliability.



Integrations

Integrations are a third-party source that link to your smart appliances and apps for easy accessibility and control. The most common integrations are Amazon Alexa, Google Home, and IFTTT.



Syncs with Compatible Products

Many of your smart appliances can sync up with one another for better operation. This is often common between ranges and range hoods as well as washers and dryers.

For example, your range hood can automatically adjust its ventilation depending on what you're cooking on your range. Your dryer can also sense when a load is done in the washer and notify you to switch loads.



Guided Cooking

Most smart cooking appliances, such as your range, wall oven, or specialty ovens, feature Guided Cooking programs to save your favorite recipes, provide recipe instructions, and adjust the cooking pace. Guided cooking programs such as Miele's MasterChef or Wolf's Gourmet, can adjust the time and temperature for you once you select the type of food you're cooking and how you want it done.

With most guided cooking programs, you can access all these features remotely on your phone or through a kitchen hub. Some programs even include a camera in your oven to watch your food's progress.




Smart Cleaning

Smart cleaning in dishwashers and laundry units will send notifications for your wash and dry cycles through its corresponding app.

Smart dishwasher notifications share when the cycle is complete, if detergent is running low, and if your dishwasher is leaking. They also have sensors for temperature control.

Smart washers and dryers can share status notifications and remotely turn your machines on or off. They can also recommend cycle options by sensing the soil level or after you've selected the fabric type. Some smart laundry units are compatible with Amazon's Alexa or Google Home with voice integration.



Smart Grilling

Smart grilling allows a customer to have the accessibility to step-by-step assistance and notifications.

With smart grilling assistance, you can monitor your grill's temperature and see countdowns to when your food is done. It will also alert you when to flip your food and when it reached the desired internal temperature.

Your smart grill does this by using a temperature probe. This is especially helpful when you're grilling a protein such as fish or steak.

Lynx Professional Grills uses MyChef, for example. MyChef provides guided cooking assistance and integrates voice commands.



Brands

We discuss every brand's smart features.





Beko, a Turkish manufacturer, does not have many smart appliances like many of its competitors. Beko's best appliances are their smart dishwashers.

Through the HomeWhiz app, Beko's dishwashers allow you to customize the wash cycle, notify you when the cycle is done, and recommend the perfect wash for your dishes.

For smart cooking appliances, Beko only includes smart cleaning functionality and intuitive smart controls.





Bosch has many good smart features and a large variety of smart products.

Through Bosch's app, you can monitor your fridge, oven, microwave, dishwasher, laundry, and even a coffee maker through their app. The app will alert you if a cycle or timer is if a door is ajar or a leak. The app also lets you customize laundry or dishwasher cycles.

The only thing Bosch lacks for smart appliances is guided cooking.

Their smart cooking appliances have guided cooking with step-by-step instructions for a better cooking experience. Overall, Café Appliance's best smart feature and the most advanced device is their Kitchen Hub.

Café Appliances Kitchen Hub is a large touchscreen that sits on its smart refrigerators. With the Kitchen Hub, you can access any connected device within your home. You can play music, take pictures, browse the internet, save recipes, or set reminders for yourself.




GAGGENAU

Through the SmartHQ app, you can preheat your oven, adjust temperatures, monitor wash, dry cycles, and adapt ventilation functions.




JENNAI₹

Although KitchenAid does not have many smart appliances, their cooking products are highly efficient and advanced.






LG's smart appliances include refrigeration, dishwashers, laundry, cooking, and ventilation. Through the ThinQ app, you can control and monitor all your appliances.

If you purchase Lynx smart outdoor refrigeration, you also have access to change the temperature in increments of 10 degrees. You will also receive a notification if the door is left open.




MAYTAG




Miele




WOLF
